Data Analyses from the GTCW Register of Qualified Teachers

Statistical Analyses of Newly Qualified Registered Teachers Focusing on Career Changers

Key Findings

- the proportion of males is higher amongst NQTs aged 25 and over than for those aged under 25, namely 30.5% compared to 19.4%;
- the proportion of NQTs aged 25 and over who are able to speak Welsh (30.0%) is lower than the figure for under 25s (39.0%). A similar pattern is evident is respect of NQTs able to teach through the medium of Welsh;
- though not true for all subjects, in general more NQTs aged 25 and over are trained in shortage secondary subjects than their counterparts who are aged under 25. For example, 69.8% of those NQTs trained to teach English are aged 25 or over and 70.6% of those NQTs trained to teach Physics;
- for the cohort selected for analysis, those aged under 25 were marginally more successful in securing substantive teaching posts and meeting the Practising Teacher Standards.

Notes

- the cohort used for tables 1 to 8 were awarded QTS between 1st April 2012 and 31st March 2013 and were registered with GTCW on the 31st March 2013;
- the cohort used for tables 9 and 10 were awarded QTS between 1st April 2007 and 31st March 2008 and were registered with GTCW on the 31st March 2013;
- all teachers followed a course of initial teacher training at an accredited institution in Wales or England or they followed a work-based route such as the Graduate Teacher Programme or School Centered Initial Teacher Training (SCITT) Course;
- the data provided in each table is split into those that were under 25 years of age at the time of qualification and those that were aged 25 and over;
- all data provided relates to "registered teachers" and the numbers are displayed as "actuals" rather than "full-time equivalents;"
- in table 8 the subject trained relates to the first subject held on the Register;
- the data used for tables 9 & 10 was taken from the Register of Qualified Teachers on the 31st March for each year 2009 2013.







3. The number of registered teachers awarded QTS between 01/04/2012 – 31/03/2013 split by gender and age


Age Profile of Split by Gender






5. The number of registered teachers awarded QTS between 01/04/2012 – 31/03/2013 by the ability to teach through the medium of Welsh




